Citizenship (Amendment) Act, 2019 The act was the first time that religion had been overtly used as a criterion for citizenship under Indian law, and it attracted global criticism. It amended the Citizenship Act, 1955 by providing The Citizenship (Amendment) Act, 2019 (CAA) was passed by the Parliament of India on 11 December 2019. Additionally, the act excludes 58,000 Sri Lankan Tamil refugees, who have lived in India since the 1980s. The law does not grant such eligibility to Muslims from these Islamic countries. The eligible minorities were stated as Hindus, Sikhs, Buddhists, Jains, Parsis or Christians. It amended the Citizenship Act, 1955 by providing an accelerated pathway to Indian citizenship for persecuted refugees of religious minorities from Islamic countries Afghanistan, Bangladesh and Pakistan who arrived in India by 2014. Crimes Act 1961 All common law offences are abolished by section 9, as are all offences against acts of the British Parliaments, but section 20 saves the old common law defences where they are not specifically altered. 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French criminal law It is one of the branches of the juridical system of the French Republic. There have been numerous amendments and reforms since the 1994 code was promulgated. In this sense it is of a punitive nature, as opposed to civil law in France, which settles disputes between individuals, or administrative law which deals with issues between individuals and government. Its function is to define, categorize, prevent, and punish criminal offenses committed by a person, whether a natural person (Personne physique) or a legal person (Personne morale). The field of criminal law is defined as a sector of French law, and is a combination of public and private law, insofar as it punishes private behavior on behalf of society as a whole. In 2010, there was the law criminalizing psychological violence within French criminal law is "the set of legal rules that govern the State's response to offenses and offenders"
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The Crimes Act is administered by the Ministry of Justice. The act has 14 parts dealing with various issues including

Uniform Civil Code Personal laws cover marriage, divorce, inheritance, adoption and maintenance. Currently, personal laws of minority religious communities are governed by their religious scriptures.
