Crest factor Higher crest factors indicate peaks, for example

sound waves tend to have high crest factors. reduction techniques (CFR) have been proposed for OFDM. In other words, crest factor indicates how extreme the peaks are in a waveform.

Crest factor 1 indicates no peaks, such as direct current or a square wave. The reduction in crest factor results in a system that can either transmit more bits per second Crest factor is a parameter of a waveform, such as alternating current or sound, showing the ratio of peak values to the effective value

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Orthogonal frequency-division multiplexing so far limited OFDM applications to terrestrial systems. The crest factor CF (in dB) for an OFDM system with n uncorrelated subcarriers is $C F = 10 \log$
