Grades can be expressed as letters (usually A to F), as a range (for example, 1 to 6), percentages, or as numbers out of a possible total (often out of 100) 1a27345d09

Grade inflation change in grades from the mid-1970s to mid-1980s; a slow rise in grades from the mid-1980s to present. Until recently, the evidence for grade inflation Grade inflation (also known as grading leniency) is the general awarding of higher grades for the same quality of work over time, which devalues grades. For this to be grade inflation, it is necessary to demonstrate that the quality of work does not deserve the high grade. However, higher average grades in themselves do not prove grade inflation 1a27345d09

Lew Grade Originally a dancer, and later a talent agent, Grade's interest in television production began in 1954 when he founded the Incorporated Television Company (ITC; commonly known as ITC Entertainment) to distribute programmes, and following the success of The Adventures of Robin Hood decided to focus on bringing them to the American market. programmes until the mid-1960s. Grade had some success in this field with such series as Gerry Anderson's many Supermarionation series such as Thunderbirds, Patrick McGoochan's The Prisoner, and Jim Henson's The Muppet Show. Later, Grade invested in feature film production, but several expensive box-office failures caused him to lose control of.
