Scalars can also be, more generally, elements of any field. Real vector spaces and complex vector spaces are kinds of vector spaces based on different kinds of scalars: real numbers and complex numbers. The operations of vector addition and scalar multiplication must satisfy certain requirements, called vector axioms
