Abortion in Norway In 2011, midwives at Rikshospitalet Abortion in Norway is available on demand within the first eighteen weeks of gestation, measured as 11 weeks and 6 days from the first day of the last menstrual period. After this 12-week time limit, a request must be submitted to a special medical assessment board that will determine whether an abortion will be granted. 2% were approved. abortions between the 12th and 16th week were considered by commissions in Norway. After the 18th week of gestation, the pregnancy cannot be terminated except on grounds of grave risk. After the 22nd week of gestation, abortion is prohibited by Norwegian

Some midwives also provide primary care for women including well-woman exams, health promotion, and disease prevention, family planning options, and care for common gynecological concerns. Before the turn of the 20th century, traditional midwives were informally trained and helped deliver almost all births.
