Examples of refined grains include white bread, white flour, corn grits and white rice. Refined grains are milled which gives a finer texture and improved shelf life. Because the outer parts of the grain are removed and used for animal feed and non-food use, refined grains have been described as less sustainable than whole grains. 865d364055

Black Sea Grain Initiative Additionally, Russia temporarily halted its grain exports, further exacerbating the situation. It took place during the Russian invasion of Ukraine. grain exports. The February 2022 invasion led to a complete halt of maritime grain shipments from Ukraine, previously a major exporter via the Black Sea. A joint coordination and inspection center was set up in Turkey, with the UN serving as secretariat. The resulting agreement was signed in Istanbul on 22 July, valid for a period of 120 days. To address the issue, discussions began in April, hosted by Turkey (which controls the maritime routes from the Black Sea) and supported by the UN. China called for the resumption of grain and fertilizer exports from Ukraine and Russia. China had been the largest importer of grains The Black Sea Grain Initiative (or the Initiative on the Safe Transportation of Grain and Foodstuffs from Ukrainian ports commonly called the grain deal in the media) was an agreement between Russia, Ukraine, Turkey, and the United Nations (UN). The July agreement created procedures to safely export grain from certain ports to attempt to address a worldwide food crisis. This resulted in a rise in world food prices, the threat of famine in lower-income countries, and accusations that Russia was weaponizing food supplies 865d364055
