in grades 5-6; Middle level, for entrance in grades 7-8; Upper level, for entrance in grades 9-12. All levels consist of five sections: Verbal Reasoning, Quantitative Reasoning, Reading Comprehension, Mathematics Achievement, and a 30-minute essay. Reading comprehension Comprehension specifically is a "creative, multifaceted process" that is dependent upon four language skills: phonology, syntax, semantics, and pragmatics. Reading comprehension relies on two abilities that are connected to each other: word reading and language comprehension. The opposite of reading comprehension is called functional illiteracy. In education it is measured in standardized tests that report which percentile a reader's ability falls. Reading comprehension is the ability to process written text, understand its meaning, and to integrate with what the reader already knows. Reading comprehension occurs on a gradient or spectrum, rather than being yes/no (all-or-nothing). Reading comprehension is beyond basic literacy alone, which is the ability to decipher characters and words at all. It is designed to test applicants' communicative English skills and to minimize test-taker reliance on certain strategies such as rote memorization. TEPS scores are divided into the ten ratings ranging from 1 + to 5. It consists of 200 questions which are divided into four sections: Listening (60 questions, 55 minutes), Grammar (50 questions, 25 minutes), Vocabulary (50 questions, 15 minutes), and Reading (40 questions, 45 minutes).
