Following significant advances in digital audio technology during the 1970s and 1980s, it gradually replaced analog audio technology in many areas of audio engineering, record production and telecommunications in the 1990s and 2000s. For example, in CD audio, samples are taken 44,100 times per second, each with 16-bit resolution.
