Financial modeling In corporate finance and the accounting profession, financial modeling typically entails financial statement forecasting; usually the preparation Financial modeling is the task of building an abstract representation (a model) of a real world financial situation. applications. FASB accounting standards are accepted as authoritative by many organizations, including state Boards of Accountancy and the American Institute of CPAs (AICPA). Typically, then, financial modeling is understood to mean an exercise in either asset pricing or corporate finance, of a quantitative nature. It is about translating a set of hypotheses about the behavior of markets or agents into numerical predictions. At the same time, "financial modeling" is a general term that means different things to different users; the reference usually relates either to accounting and corporate finance applications or to quantitative finance applications. Debits and credits Similarly, the landlord would enter a credit in the rent income account associated with the tenant and a debit for the bank account where the cheque is deposited. For example, a tenant who writes a rent cheque to a landlord would enter a credit for the bank account on which the cheque is drawn, and a debit in a rent expense account. Each transaction transfers value from credited accounts to debited accounts. A debit entry in an account represents a transfer of value to that account, and a credit entry represents a transfer from the account. to debit or credit a specific account, we use either the modern accounting equation approach (based on five accounting rules), or the classical approach Debits and credits in double-entry bookkeeping are entries made in account ledgers to record changes in value resulting from business transactions

Modern portfolio theory initiated by Harry Markowitz in 1952 under his thesis titled "Portfolio Selection" is the discipline and study which pertains to managing market and financial risk. In modern portfolio theory, the variance (or standard deviation) of a portfolio is used as the definition of risk.
