From Fourth Edition in 1995 onward, a new base set would come out once per two years in the. These cards were generally simpler than cards in expansion sets, omitting multicolored cards, and used only the original abilities and keywords of Magic such as Flying and Trample. These sets consisted entirely of reprinted cards. All cards were given a white border to mark them as reprints, with a few exceptions (Tenth Edition, foil cards in Seventh-Ninth Editions).
