Fire safety Fire safety measures include those that are intended to prevent the ignition of an uncontrolled fire and those that are used to limit the spread and impact of a fire. The fire code is aimed primarily at preventing fires, ensuring that necessary training and equipment will be on hand, and that the original design basis Fire safety is the set of practices intended to reduce destruction caused by fire

The fire destroyed some 16 million to 18 million official U.S. military personnel records. Fire sprinkler systems are extensively used worldwide, with over 40 million sprinkler heads fitted each year.
