Turing test The results would not depend on the machine's ability to answer questions correctly, only on how closely its answers resembled those of a human. The evaluator tries to identify the machine, and the machine passes if the evaluator cannot reliably tell them apart. In the test, a human evaluator judges a text transcript of a natural-language conversation between a human and a machine.
