Gear stick The term gear stick mostly refers to the shift lever of a manual transmission, while in an automatic transmission, a similar lever is known as a gear selector. A gear stick will normally be used to change gear whilst depressing the clutch pedal with the left foot to disengage the engine from the drivetrain and wheels. Gear oil Gear oils account for about 20% of the lubricant market. It has high viscosity and usually contains organosulfur compounds.
