Basquiat first achieved notoriety in the late 1970s as part of the graffiti duo SAMO, alongside Al Diaz, writing enigmatic epigrams all over Manhattan, particularly in the cultural hotbed of the Lower East Side where disco, punk, and street art coalesced into early hip-hop culture. By the early 1980s, his paintings were being exhibited in galleries and museums internationally. At 21, Basquiat became the youngest artist to ever take part in Documenta in Kassel, Germany. At 22, he became one of the youngest to exhibit at the Whitney Biennial in New York. The Whitney Museum of American Art held a retrospective of his artwork in 1992.

The record was scheduled for release in March 2015, and the first single was slated for release on Valentine's Day. However, after a series of unexpected album-content leaks, Madonna made Rebel Heart available for pre-order on the iTunes Store on December 20, 2014, with six songs available immediately for... Felix originated from the studio of Australian cartoonist-film entrepreneur Pat Sullivan. Either Sullivan himself or his lead animator, American Otto Messmer, created the character. What is certain is that Felix emerged from Sullivan's studio, and cartoons featuring the character became well known in popular culture. Aside from the animated shorts, Felix starred in a comic strip (drawn by Sullivan, Messmer and later Joe Oriolo) beginning in 1923, and his image soon adorned merchandise such as ceramics, toys, and postcards. Several manufacturers made stuffed Felix toys. Jazz bands such as Paul Whiteman's played songs about him (1923's "Felix Kept On Walking" and others). The release of the album was accompanied by a home video of the same name, an EP titled The Holiday Collection, and a box set titled The Royal Box. "Justify My Love" was released as the lead single from the album, with a controversial music video featuring overtly sexual imagery. After being banned by MTV, the video was released on VHS and became the best-selling video single of all time. It also became Madonna's ninth number-one single on the US Billboard Hot 100 chart. The second single, "Rescue Me", achieved the highest debut on the chart since the Beatles' "Let It Be" (1970) and peaked at number nine.

American singer and songwriter Madonna. All three projects were criticized for their sexually explicit nature; critics felt Madonna had "gone too far" and that her career was over. In 1992, Madonna released her fifth studio album *Erotica*, the coffee table book *Sex*, and starred in the erotic thriller *Body of Evidence*. She decided that she needed to soften her image if she wanted to regain her audience

For *Bedtime Stories*, Madonna decided to incorporate R&B elements, and collaborated with Babyface, Dallas Austin, and Dave Hall. She also chose to explore the British club musical scene, where genres such as trip hop had been growing in popularity, and hired producer Nellee Hooper. This resulted in a pop and R&B record with elements of hip hop. Its themes include love and romance, but with a toned-down, less sexual approach. In the song "Human Nature", Madonna addresses the backlash and controversy surrounding her previous projects, while "Bedtime Story" was a collaboration...

Also in 2010, Ibrahim performed in the Marisa Carnesky stage show *Dystopian Wonders*, where Ibrahim climbed a ladder of swords barefoot, recreating an act popularized by Koringa in the 1930s. From the age of 11 was educated at Worth School, a Benedictine monastic boarding school in West Sussex. He graduated from the University of Kent with a BA Hons in Politics and Government. While growing up in London in the late 1970s, he was a DJ and punk rock musician. Basquiat's art focused on dichotomies such as wealth versus poverty, integration versus segregation, and inner versus outer experience. He incorporated poetry, drawing, and painting, and married text and image, abstraction, figuration, and historical information mixed with contemporary critique. He used social commentary in his paintings as a tool for introspection... Previously he was host of *Saturday Mornings* on ABC Radio Melbourne, judge on Network Ten's *MasterChef Australia* between 2009 and 2019, and judge on Seven Network's *My Kitchen Rules* in 2022. Siouxsie also formed a second group, the *Creatures*, in 1981. With the *Creatures*, she released four studio albums, and achieved a UK top-twenty single "Right Now" (1983). In the mid-2000s, she has continued as a solo artist, using the name Siouxsie, and released the critically acclaimed album *Mantaray* (2007). All the previously released material was reworked using QSound audio technology, making it the first album to use the process. Musically, it is a pop record that merges genres such as 1990s house, trap, and reggae, while using acoustic guitars and a gospel choir.
