It can also be given through bypassing the airway, such as in ECMO therapy. Oxygen therapy is often useful in chronic hypoxemia caused by conditions such as severe COPD or cystic fibrosis. these recommendations include carbon monoxide poisoning, cluster headaches, sickle cell crisis, and pneumothorax. Acute indications for therapy include hypoxemia (low blood oxygen levels), carbon monoxide toxicity and cluster headache.
