It interacts with the

human endocannabinoid system. The underlying mechanism that caused the acute neurotoxicity of this molecule remains unknown. The drug was in development for the treatment of a range of different medical conditions from anxiety disorder to Parkinson's disease, also for the treatment of chronic pain of multiple sclerosis, cancer, hypertension, or the treatment of obesity. Deming regression It is a special case of total least squares, which allows for any number of predictors and a more complicated error structure. packages used in clinical chemistry offer Deming regression. It differs from the simple linear regression in that it accounts for errors in observations on both the x- and the y- axis.
