In Kenya the basic training for clinical officers starts after high school and takes four or five years ending on successful completion of a one-year internship in a teaching hospital and registration at the Clinical Officers Council where annual practice licenses are issued. Dental follicle In addition, it may be the precursor of other cells of the periodontium, including osteoblasts, cementoblasts and fibroblasts. The dental follicle (DF) differentiates into the periodontal ligament. It is a vascular fibrous sac containing the developing tooth and its odontogenic organ. Similar to dental papilla, the dental follicle provides nutrition to the enamel organ and dental papilla and also have an extremely rich blood supply. The dental follicle, also known as dental sac, is made up of mesenchymal cells and fibres surrounding the enamel organ and dental papilla of a developing tooth. They develop into the alveolar bone, the cementum with Sharpey's fibers and the periodontal ligament fibers respectively 9076191592
