American Guide Series The series not only detailed the histories of the 48 states, but provided insight to their cultures as well. The format was uniform, comprising essays on the state's history and culture, descriptions of its major cities, automobile tours of important attractions, and a portfolio of photographs. In total, the project employed over 6,000 writers.
