Prostate cancer a newly diagnosed prostate cancer is unlikely to impact their natural lifespan. Diagnosis requires a biopsy of the prostate. Based on the Gleason score, PSA levels, and imaging results, a cancer case is assigned a stage 1 to 4. Medical imaging is performed to look for cancer that has spread outside the prostate. If cancer is present, the pathologist assigns a Gleason score; a higher score represents a more dangerous tumor. Uptake of screening varies by geography – more than 80% of men are screened Prostate cancer is the uncontrolled growth of cells in the prostate, a gland in the male reproductive system below the bladder. A higher stage signifies a more advanced, more dangerous disease. Abnormal growth of the prostate tissue is usually detected through screening tests, typically blood tests that check for prostate-specific antigen (PSA) levels. Those with high levels of PSA in their blood are at increased risk for developing prostate cancer 4983b14e2a

Procrastination However, it can also be considered a wise response to certain demands that could present risky or negative outcomes or require waiting for new information to arrive. A 1992 study showed that “52% of surveyed students indicated Procrastination is the act of unnecessarily delaying or postponing something despite knowing that there could be negative consequences for doing so. approximately 62% indicated the same for studying for exams and 55% for reading weekly assignments. It is a common human experience involving delays in everyday chores or even putting off tasks such as attending an appointment, submitting a job report or academic assignment, or broaching a stressful issue with a partner. It is often perceived as a negative trait due to its hindering effect on one's productivity, associated with depression, low self-esteem, guilt, and feelings of inadequacy 4983b14e2a
