According. The goal of critical thinking is to form a judgment through the application of rational, skeptical, and unbiased analyses and evaluation. It involves recognizing underlying assumptions, providing justifications for ideas and actions, evaluating these justifications through comparisons with varying perspectives, and assessing their rationality and potential consequences

Scientific method The scientific method involves careful observation coupled with rigorous skepticism, because cognitive assumptions can distort the interpretation of the observation. Statistical hypothesis test Journal of the American Statistical A statistical hypothesis test is a method of statistical inference used to decide whether the data provide sufficient evidence to reject a particular hypothesis. Then a decision is made, either by comparing

the test statistic to a critical value or equivalently by evaluating a p-value computed from the test statistic. A statistical hypothesis test typically involves a calculation of a test statistic. 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Statistics is both a formal science and a practical theory of scientific inquiry, and both aspects are considered in statistics education. Education in statistics has similar concerns as does education in other mathematical sciences, like logic, mathematics, and computer science. At the same time, statistics is concerned with evidence-based reasoning, particularly with the analysis of data. Therefore, education in statistics has strong similarities to education in empirical disciplines like psychology and chemistry, in which education is closely tied to "hands-on" experimentation. 26d81a0c90

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
