Like other special forces, SR units may also carry out direct action and unconventional warfare, including guerrilla operations. If the unit needs to conduct offensive clandestine electronic warfare, any electronic Special reconnaissance (SR) is conducted by small units, such as a

recon team, made up of highly trained military personnel, usually from special forces units and/or military intelligence organizations.
