Fraction the notation a/b can also be used for mathematical expressions that do not represent a rational number (for example 2^2). A fraction (from Latin: fractus, "broken") represents a part of a whole or, more generally, any number of equal parts. A common, vulgar, or simple fraction (examples: $1/2$ and $17/3$) consists of an integer numerator, displayed above a line (or before a slash like $1/2$), and a non-zero integer denominator, displayed below (or after) that line. For example, in the fraction $3/4$, the numerator 3 indicates that the fraction represents 3 equal parts, and the denominator 4 indicates. When spoken in everyday English, a fraction describes how many parts of a certain size there are, for example, one-half, eight-fifths, three-quarters. If these integers are positive, then the numerator represents a number of equal parts, and the denominator indicates how many of those parts make up a unit or a whole.

Rational and irrational motivation play a key role in the field of economics. Motivation is studied in fields like psychology, motivation science, neuroscience, and philosophy. In order to predict Motivation is an internal state that propels individuals to engage in goal-directed behavior. It is a complex phenomenon and its precise definition is disputed.

At an elementary level the division of two natural numbers is, among other possible interpretations, the process of calculating the number of times one number is contained within another. For example, if 20 apples are divided evenly between 4 people, everyone receives 5 apples (see picture). However, this number of times or the number contained (divisor) need not be integers. Originally specified in the late 1950s, it is the second-oldest high-level programming language still in common use, after Fortran. Albert Ellis He is generally considered to be one of the originators of the cognitive revolutionary paradigm shift in psychotherapy and

an early proponent and developer of cognitive-behavioral therapies. He held MA and PhD degrees in clinical psychology from Columbia University, and was certified by the American Board of Professional Psychology (ABPP). He also founded, and was the President of, the New York City-based Albert Ellis Institute.

Number As only a relatively small number of symbols can be memorized, basic numerals are commonly arranged in a numeral system, which is an organized way to represent any number. Individual numbers can be represented in language with number words or by dedicated symbols called numerals; for example, "five" is a number word and "5" is the corresponding numeral. The most common numeral system is the Hindu–Arabic numeral system, which allows for the representation of any non-negative integer using a combination of ten fundamental numeric symbols, called digits.
