At the start of 2024, Steward operated 33 hospitals and employed 33,000 people in the United States, however that number decreased significantly due to the company's May 2024 bankruptcy filing. Steward's international ventures included Steward Colombia, which operates four hospitals, and Steward Middle East, which operates in Saudi Arabia and the United Arab Emirates.
