Nonmetal They range from colorless gases like hydrogen to shiny crystals like iodine. form negatively charged ions with oxygen in aqueous solutions. Drawing on this, in 1864 the "Manual of Metalloids" divided all elements into either metals In the context of the periodic table, a nonmetal is a chemical element that mostly lacks distinctive metallic properties. Chemically, nonmetals have relatively high electronegativity or usually attract electrons in a chemical bond with another element, and their oxides tend to be acidic. Physically, they are usually lighter (less dense) than elements that form metals and are often poor conductors of heat and electricity ddd577ac7b

Small ι , o and u are also rarely used, since they closely resemble the Latin letters *i*, *o* and *u*. In these contexts, the capital letters and the small letters represent distinct and unrelated entities.
