Disinfectant Disinfection does not necessarily kill all microorganisms, especially resistant bacterial spores; it is less effective than sterilization, which is an extreme physical or chemical process that kills all types of life. It is also a form of decontamination. Biocides are intended to destroy all forms of life, not just microorganisms, whereas disinfectants work by destroying the cell wall of microbes or interfering with their metabolism. Disinfectants are generally distinguished from other antimicrobial agents such as antibiotics, which destroy microorganisms within the body, and antiseptics, which destroy microorganisms on living tissue. European approach for disinfectant validation consists of a basic suspension test, a quantitative suspension test (with low and high levels of organic material A disinfectant is a chemical substance or compound used to inactivate or destroy microorganisms on inert surfaces. Virucides are to be used outside the human body, and as such fall into the category of disinfectants (applied not to the human body) and antiseptics (applied to the surface of skin) for those safe enough. Norovirus Complications are uncommon, but may include dehydration, especially in the young, the old, and those with other health problems.
