Scratch (programming language) Scratch is a high-level, block-based visual programming language and website aimed primarily at children as an educational tool, with a target audience of ages 8 to 16. Scratch is developed by the MIT Media Lab and has been translated into 70+ languages, being used in most parts of the world. Scratch was conceived and designed through collaborative National Science Foundation grants awarded to Mitchel Resnick and Yasmin Kafai. As of 15 February 2023, community statistics on the language's official website show more than 123 million projects shared by over 103 million users, and more than. Scratch is taught and used in after-school centers, schools, and colleges, as well as other public knowledge institutions.

C (programming language) It was created in the 1970s by Dennis Ritchie and remains widely used and influential. C is used on computers that range from the largest supercomputers to the smallest microcontrollers and embedded systems. It has been and continues to be used to implement operating systems (especially kernels), device drivers, and protocol stacks, but its use in application software has been decreasing. By design, C gives the programmer relatively direct access to the features of the typical CPU architecture, customized for the target instruction set. scope of logic can therefore be very large, ranging from core topics such as the study of fallacies and paradoxes, to specialized analyses of reasoning such as probability, correct reasoning, and arguments involving causality. Logicians study the criteria for the evaluation of arguments. Logic investigates and classifies the structure of statements and arguments, both through the study of formal systems of inference and the study of arguments in natural language.
