Cameron's inspiration came from his fascination with shipwrecks. He felt a love story interspersed with human loss would be essential to convey the emotional impact of the disaster. Production began on September 1, 1995, when Cameron shot footage of the Titanic wreck. The modern scenes were shot on board the Shirshov Institute of Oceanology research vessel Akademik Mstislav Keldysh, which Cameron had used as a base when filming the wreck. Scale models, computer-generated imagery (CGI), and a reconstruction of the Titanic built at Baja Studios were used to recreate the sinking. After the rival Cunard Line put out the RMS Lusitania and RMS Mauretania,

the largest and fastest ships in the world, Ismay green-lighted the building of the Olympic-class and ordered the building of three large liners with focus on comfort and safety. 1818e3c24b
