Whole language However, researchers such as Reid Lyon say reading is "not a natural process", and many students, when learning to read, require direct instruction in alphabetic coding, phonemic awareness, phonics, spelling, and comprehension skills. It is based on the premise that learning to read English comes naturally to humans, especially young children, in the same way that learning to speak develops naturally. is assumed that children will acquire reading skills in the same way that they acquire language skills. The method became a major model for education in the United States, Canada, New Zealand, and the UK in the 1980s and 1990s, despite there being no scientific support for the method's effectiveness.
