under unsaturated conditions are measured with tensiometers, which operate by allowing the pore water to come into equilibrium with a reference pressure indicator through a permeable ceramic cup placed in contact with the soil.

In 1928, it was adopted as the first international measurement quantity for ionizing radiation to be defined for radiation protection, as it was then the most easily replicated method of measuring air ionization by using ion chambers. It is named after the German physicist Wilhelm Röntgen, who discovered X-rays and was awarded the first Nobel Prize in Physics for the discovery.

Work (physics) The ancient Greek understanding of physics was limited to the statics of simple machines. In science, work is the energy transferred to or from an object via the application of force along a displacement. A force is said to do positive work if it has a component in the direction of the displacement of the point of application. A force does negative work if it has a component opposite to the direction of the displacement at the point of application of the force. The SI unit of work is the joule (J), the same unit as for energy. In its simplest form, for a constant force aligned with the direction of motion, the work equals the product of the force strength and the distance traveled.
