Cessna 400 production was ended in February 2018. Over 4,400 were built with production ceasing in 1985. When Cessna re-introduced some of its most popular models in the 1990s, the tailwheel equipped Cessna 180 and 185 were not put back into production. The C75 was in production from 1943 to 1952 and the C85 from 1944 to 1970.
