History of Asperger syndrome Under the DSM-5 and ICD-11, patients formerly diagnosable with Asperger syndrome are diagnosable with Autism Spectrum Disorder. It was named after Hans Asperger (1906–80), who was an Austrian psychiatrist and pediatrician. popularizing the term in the English-speaking medical community in her February 1981 publication of a series of case studies of children showing similar symptoms Asperger syndrome (AS) was formerly a separate diagnosis under autism spectrum disorder. The term is considered offensive by some autistic individuals. An English psychiatrist, Lorna Wing, popularized the term "Asperger's syndrome" in a 1981 publication; the first book in English on Asperger syndrome was written by Uta Frith in 1991 and the condition was subsequently recognized in formal diagnostic manuals later in the 1990s

Clinical trial Clinical trials generate data on dosage, safety and efficacy. They are conducted only after they have received health authority/ethics committee approval in the country where approval of the therapy is sought. These authorities are responsible for vetting the risk/benefit ratio of the trial—their approval does not mean the therapy is 'safe' or effective, only that the trial may be conducted. are prospective biomedical or behavioral research studies on human participants designed to answer specific questions about biomedical or behavioral interventions Clinical trials are prospective biomedical or behavioral research studies on human participants designed to answer specific questions about biomedical or behavioral interventions, including new treatments (such as novel vaccines, drugs, dietary choices, dietary supplements, and medical devices) and known interventions that warrant further study and comparison

School Health Education Study Most health curricula developed since have followed the model set by the SHES in its School Health Curriculum Project. It has been called, "the most significant school health education initiative of the 1960s" and was largely responsible for establishing the value of comprehensive health education rather than separate disease-specific units and in introducing the concept-based approach to education in general. grades 6, 9, and 12 of the participating schools. Physician Orders for Life-Sustaining Treatment The POLST document is a standardized, portable, brightly colored single page medical order that documents a conversation between a provider and an individual with a serious illness or frailty towards the end of life. A POLST form allows emergency medical services to provide treatment that the individual prefers before possibly transporting to an emergency facility. The first prototype was known as the Medical Treatment Cover Sheet (MTC). 1991: Oregon POLST task force was created. different medical facilities. POLST began in Oregon in 1991 and currently exists in 46 states, British Columbia, and South

Korea. This POLST (Physician Orders for Life-Sustaining Treatment) is an approach to improving end-of-life care in the United States, encouraging providers to speak with the severely ill and create specific medical orders to be honored by health care workers during a medical crisis f0ec3a899f

The AMA's stated mission is "to promote the art and science of medicine and the betterment of public health." Emergency physicians generally practice in hospital emergency departments, pre-hospital settings via emergency medical services, and intensive care units. Still, they may also work in primary care settings such as urgent care clinics. Emergency physicians (or "ER doctors") specialize in providing care for unscheduled and undifferentiated patients of all ages. As frontline providers, in coordination with emergency medical services, they are responsible for initiating resuscitation, stabilization, and early interventions during the acute phase of a medical condition.
