Responsibility-driven design is in direct contrast with data-driven design, which promotes defining the behavior of a class along with the data that

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it holds. Object-relational impedance mismatch data in a dedicated database, while object-oriented (OO) programming is the default method for business-centric design in programming languages. Both logical models are differently implementable using database servers, programming languages, design patterns, or other technologies.
