HLA-A HLA-A is one of three major types of human MHC class I transmembrane proteins. The $\beta 2$ microglobulin protein is encoded by the B2M gene, which is located at chromosome 15q21. The others are HLA-B and HLA-C. HLA is a major histocompatibility complex (MHC) antigen specific to humans. promotes genetic diversity in the population. The protein is a heterodimer, and is composed of a heavy α chain and smaller β chain. 3. The α chain is encoded by a variant HLA-A gene, and the β chain ($\beta 2$ -microglobulin) is an invariant $\beta 2$ microglobulin molecule. Since each HLA has a different affinity for peptides of

Ligand binding assay If the ligand were to have bound to multiple sites that have differing radioligand affinities, then the Scatchard plot A ligand binding assay (LBA) is an assay, or an analytic procedure, which relies on the binding of ligand molecules to receptors, antibodies or other macromolecules. radioligand binds with a single affinity. This type of analytic test can be used to test for the presence of target molecules in a sample that are known to bind to the receptor. A detection method is used to determine the presence and amount of the ligand-receptor complexes formed, and this is usually determined electrochemically or through a fluorescence detection method

His-tag It is also known as a hexa histidine-tag, 6xHis-tag, or His6 tag. Proteins can coordinate A polyhistidine-tag, best known by the trademarked name His-tag, is an amino acid motif in proteins that typically consists of at least six histidine (His) residues, often at the N- or C-terminus of the protein. endoprotease-based tag removal. Various purification kits for histidine-tagged proteins are commercially available from multiple companies. The tag was invented by Roche, although the use of histidines and its vectors are distributed by Qiagen. Polyhistidine-tags are often used for affinity purification of genetically modified proteins
