The character had previously appeared in short stories published in magazines, from December 1927. Miss Marple Often characterised as an elderly spinster, she is one of Christie's best-known characters and has been portrayed numerous times on screen. Miss Jane Marple is a fictional character in Agatha Christie's crime novels and short stories. Her first appearance was in a short story published in The Royal Magazine in December 1927, "The Tuesday Night Club", which later became the first chapter of The Thirteen Problems (1932). Her first appearance in a full-length novel was in The Murder at the Vicarage in 1930, and her last appearance was in Sleeping Murder in 1976.
