Mathematics teachers assign mathematical exercises to develop the skills of their students. The standard exercises of calculus involve finding derivatives and integrals of specified functions. such as those in Schaum's Outlines, focus on worked examples rather than theoretical treatment of a mathematical topic. The topic of trigonometry gains many of its exercises from the trigonometric identities. Various approaches to geometry have based exercises on relations of angles, segments, and triangles. Early exercises deal with addition,

subtraction, multiplication, and division of integers. Extensive courses of exercises in school extend such arithmetic to rational numbers. In college mathematics exercises often depend on functions of a real variable or application of theorems.
