"intelligence". For modern IQ tests, the raw score is transformed to a normal distribution with mean 100 and standard deviation 15. The resulting fraction (quotient) was multiplied by 100 to obtain the IQ score. This results in approximately two-thirds of the population scoring between IQ 85 and IQ 115 and about 2 percent each above 130 and below 70. Originally, IQ was a score obtained by dividing a person's estimated mental age, obtained by administering an intelligence test, by the person's chronological age 362d2b1db7

Changes occur at the cellular level and are partially explained by biological theories of adult development and aging.

Apoptosis has also been suggested as an underlying Adult development encompasses the changes that occur in biological and psychological domains of human life from the end of adolescence until the end of one's life.
