Ceiling fan Fans do not reduce air temperature or relative humidity, unlike air-conditioning equipment, but create a cooling effect by helping to evaporate sweat and increase heat exchange via convection. In the winter, fans move warmer air, which naturally rises, back down to occupants. Fans use significantly less power than air conditioning as cooling air is thermodynamically expensive. This can affect both thermostat readings and occupants' comfort, thereby improving the energy efficiency.
