We live in a civil society, we are guided by the federal law, [and] by Lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender, and queer (LGBTQ) people in Russia face significant legal and social challenges not experienced by non-LGBT people. Transgender people are not allowed to change their legal gender and all gender-affirming. It is illegal for individuals to "promote homosexuality" and same-sex couples and households headed by same-sex couples are ineligible for the legal protections available to opposite-sex couples. Although sexual activity between consenting adults of the same sex is legal, homosexuality is disapproved of by much of the population and pro-LGBTQ advocacy groups are deemed "extremist" and banned. same-sex couples to marry both in Moscow and elsewhere in Russia are doomed to fail 35bd2d8d2f
