They carry out psychological testing, psychoeducational assessment, intervention, prevention, counseling, and consultation in the ethical, legal, and administrative codes of their profession. University counseling center (2003) A university counseling center (UCC) provides mental health and other services within a university or college environment. Among Big Ten Conference universities, directors report a 42% increase in the number of students seen at their counseling centers. objectives of university counseling centers, including creation and maintenance of pre-doctoral internship and practicum programs. In a summary of recent survey data, Duenwald also reports that the use of psychiatric medication has increased almost 10% among college students since the year 2000. Counseling center directors and other student affairs personnel have reported an increase in the mental health needs of college students, with issues like eating disorders, alcohol and drug abuse/dependence, severe depression/anxiety, suicidality, and sexual assault becoming more prevalent in this environment. Clinical neuropsychology is a specialized form of clinical psychology focused on research as a focal point of treatment within the field. For instance, a clinical neuropsychologist will be able to determine whether a symptom was caused by a traumatic injury to the head or by a neurological/psychiatric condition. Pediatric psychology Psychological issues are addressed in a developmental framework and emphasize the dynamic relationships which exist between children, their families, and the health delivery system as a whole. Graduate training typically requires 4–5 years of graduate school and an additional year spent on an internship. School psychology challenges and benefits It is an area of applied psychology practiced by a school psychologist. counseling methods, and legal and ethical issues in education. They often collaborate with educators, families, school leaders, community members, and other professionals to create safe and supportive school environments. Many programs also require students to engage in hands-on training through practicum placements School psychology is a field that applies principles from educational psychology, developmental psychology, clinical psychology, community psychology, and behavior analysis to meet the learning and behavioral health needs of children and adolescents

These student affairs practitioners work to provide services and support for students and drive student learning outside of the classroom at institutions of higher education. People who work in this field are known as student affairs educators, student affairs practitioners, or student affairs professionals

Psychologists usually acquire a bachelor's degree in psychology, followed by a master's degree or doctorate in psychology. Unlike psychiatrists and psychiatric nurse-practitioners, psychologists usually cannot prescribe medication, but depending on the jurisdiction, some psychologists with additional training can be licensed to prescribe medications; qualification requirements may be different from a bachelor's degree and master's degree. Clinical neuropsychology Clinical neuropsychologists apply their research to the assessment, diagnosis, treatment, and rehabilitation of patients with neurological, medical, neurodevelopmental, and psychiatric conditions. experience (practicum and internship). The branch of neuropsychology associated with children and young people is called pediatric neuropsychology. Practicum is between 600 and 1,000 hours of practical application of skills acquired in the program. Rehabilitation counselors can be found in private practice, in rehabilitation facilities, hospitals, universities, schools, government agencies, insurance companies and other organizations where people are being treated for congenital or acquired disabilities. Over time, with the changes in social work being more psychotherapy-oriented, rehabilitation counselors take on more and more community engagement work, especially as it relates to special populations. Some rehabilitation counselors focus solely on community engagement through vocational services, others in various states qualify as both a certified rehabilitation...
