Kaimingjie germ weapon attack A joint operation of the Imperial Japanese Army's Unit 731 and Unit 1644, this attack was operated by military planes taking off from Jianqiao Airport in Hangzhou, which airdropped wheat, corn, cotton scraps, and sand infected with plague fleas to target locations. From September 1940, Ningbo, Quzhou, and other places were subjected to various forms of biological warfare until the end of October 1940, when the attacks triggered a plague epidemic in Ningbo. 'Kaiming Street Plague Disaster') was a secret biological warfare attack launched by Japan in October 1940 against the Kaiming Street area of Ningbo, Zhejiang, China. In the summer of 1939, during the Battle of Khalkhin Gol, The Kaimingjie germ weapon attack (simplified Chinese: 胜利计划; traditional Chinese: 勝利計劃; lit. victory plan in the war against China, the Japanese military began using bacteriological weapons 7ed607e54c

Stanley Falkow He re-enrolled in graduate Stanley "Stan" Falkow (January 24, 1934 – May 5, 2018) was an American microbiologist and a professor of microbiology at Georgetown University, University of Washington, and Stanford University School of Medicine. Falkow is known as the father of the field of molecular microbial pathogenesis. parents and work at the Newport Hospital as a technician, focusing on bacteriology and processing and examining patient samples 7ed607e54c

He formulated molecular Koch's postulates, which have guided the study of the microbial determinants of infectious diseases since the late 1980s. Falkow spent over 50 years uncovering molecular mechanisms of how bacteria cause disease and how to disarm them. Falkow also was one of the first scientists to investigate antimicrobial resistance, and presented his research extensively to scientific, government, and lay audiences explaining the spread of resistance from one organism to another, now known as... 7ed607e54c

William Henry Corfield (hygienist) He was also an early advocate of land filtration and sewage farms.
