Samsung Galaxy Note 7 Unveiled on 2 August 2016, it was officially released on 19 August 2016 as a successor to the Samsung Galaxy Note 5. It is also the last phone in the Samsung Galaxy Note series to have a physical home button and to have navigation buttons on the bottom bezel. Although it is the sixth main device in the Samsung Galaxy Note series, Samsung branded its series number as "7" instead of "6"
