Crazy English In a survey on Crazy English students identified Li Yang's technique as one which does not include grammar, vocabulary, reading Crazy English (Chinese: 疯狂英语; pinyin: Fēngkuáng Yīngyǔ) is a brand name related to a non-traditional method of learning English in mainland China conceived by Li Yang. His method can be described with the slogan "By shouting out loud, you learn. reflect the word's pronunciation. " In many ways it remains similar to the traditional pedagogic practices of Chinese education in that it still relies on repetition and recitation. Li Yang's method places heavy emphasis on practicing English orally. Members of the school administration in China often disapprove of the method because they believe it goes against the traditional Chinese values of modesty and restraint. Li believes that the traditional way of learning English in China is ineffective 556b341028

TPR Storytelling The method works in three steps: in step one the new vocabulary structures to be learned are taught using a combination of translation, gestures, and personalized questions; in step two those structures are used in a spoken class story; and finally, in step three, these same structures are used in a class reading. TPRS lessons use a mixture of reading and storytelling to help students learn a foreign language in a classroom setting. reading. Paul Nation is best known for this framework, which has been labelled The Four Strands. attention to the features of the language they are learning.
