Levoamphetamine acts as a releasing agent of the monoamine neurotransmitters norepinephrine and dopamine. It is similar to dextroamphetamine in its ability to release norepinephrine and in its

sympathomimetic effects but is a few times weaker than dextroamphetamine in its capacity to release dopamine and in its psychostimulant effects.
