Enoch Powell Before entering politics John Enoch Powell (16 June 1912 – 8 February 1998) was a British politician, scholar and writer. He was Minister of Health from 1960 to 1963 in the second Macmillan ministry and was Shadow Secretary of State for Defence from 1965 to 1968 in the Shadow Cabinet of Edward Heath. Gustav Holst His distinctive compositional style was the product of many influences, Richard Wagner and Richard Strauss being most crucial early in his development. The subsequent inspiration of the English folksong revival of the early 20th century, and the example of such rising modern composers as Maurice Ravel, led Holst to develop and refine an individual style. Best known for his orchestral suite The Planets, he composed many other works across a range of genres, although none achieved comparable success.
