The results from the experiments led the scientists at the institute to research domestication of other animals, such as rats in 1972, mink, and The domesticated silver fox (*Vulpes vulpes forma amicus*) is a form of the silver fox that has been to some extent domesticated under laboratory conditions. Many of the descendant foxes became both tamer and more dog-like in morphology. The experiment at the Institute of Cytology and Genetics in Novosibirsk, Russia, explored whether selection for behaviour rather than morphology may have been the process that had produced dogs from wolves, by recording the changes in foxes when in each generation only the most tame foxes were allowed to breed.
