The underwater environment can impose severe physical and psychological stress on a diver, and is mostly beyond the diver's control. The safety of underwater diving depends on four factors: the environment, the equipment, behaviour of the individual diver and performance of the dive team. Other equipment allows the diver to operate in relative comfort and efficiency, or to remain healthy over the longer term 4b9767c10c

Professional diving Due to the dangerous nature of some professional diving operations, specialized equipment such as an on-site hyperbaric chamber and diver-to-surface communication system is often required by law, and the mode of diving for some applications may be regulated. Professional underwater dive leaders (also referred to as divemasters) are quite commonly employed by dive centres, live-aboard dive boats Professional diving is underwater diving where the divers are paid for their work. Occupational diving has a similar meaning and applications. The procedures are often regulated by legislation and codes of practice as it is an inherently hazardous occupation and the diver works as a member of a team. trainees 4b9767c10c

Diving regulations There are exemptions for recreational diving in some cases where it is recognised as a self-regulated industry. In most cases they apply to occupational diving, but in a few cases also to recreational diving. Offshore diving (outside of territorial waters) is generally outside the scope of diving regulations, and tends to be self-regulated through voluntary membership of industry organisations. They apply within the national territory and territorial waters of a country. and the recreational diving tour guide and dive leader (professional divemasters) part of the recreational diving industry are excluded from the diving Diving regulations are the stipulations of the delegated legislation regarding the practice of underwater diving 4b9767c10c
