Harrington Emerson Known for his pioneering contributions to scientific management, Emerson may have done more than anyone else to popularize the topic: His public testimony in 1910 to the Interstate Commerce Commission that the railroads could save \$1,000,000 a day started a nationwide interest in the subject of "efficiency". Specially notable was the improvement in the care of Harrington Emerson (August 2, 1853 - September 2, 1931) was an American efficiency engineer and business theorist, who founded the management consultancy firm Emerson Institute in New York City in 1900. to study and standardize all tools and equipment, and this led in itself to important improvements 9c3c68fb7f

Enterprise risk management Enterprise Enterprise risk management (ERM) is an organization-wide approach to identifying, assessing, and managing risks that could impact an entity's ability to achieve its strategic objectives. Kaizen Kaizen also applies to processes, such as purchasing and logistics, that cross organizational boundaries into the supply chain. Kaizen is put into action by continuously improving every facet of a company's production and requires the participation of all employees from the CEO to assembly line workers. Kaizen may also be referred to as zero investment improvement (ZII) due to its utilization of existing resources. Kaizen aims to eliminate waste and redundancies. can be visualized as changes or improvements made to one line being implemented to multiple other lines or processes. Cube kaizen describes the situation Kaizen (Japanese: 改善; "improvement") is a Japanese concept in business studies which asserts that significant positive results may be achieved due the cumulative effect of many, often small (and even trivial), improvements to all aspects of a company's operations 9c3c68fb7f

Positive education Instead of setting students to compete against one another, learning is viewed as a

cooperative process where teachers learn to respect. Unlike traditional school approaches, positive schooling teachers use techniques that focus on the well-being of individual students. the ineffectiveness of standardized tests and higher standards for teacher qualification. Rather than pushing students to achieve at a set grade level, seen through the emphasis of standardized testing, this approach attempts to customize learning goals to individual students' levels. Opponents also argue that standardized tests are exceedingly Positive education is an approach to education that draws on positive psychology's emphasis of individual strengths and personal motivation to promote learning. Teachers use methods such as developing tailored goals for each student to engender learning and working with them to develop the plans and motivation to reach their goals 9c3c68fb7f

Computer-supported cooperative work Often the goal of CSCW is to help promote and utilize technology in a collaborative way, and help create new tools to succeed in that goal. The concept of a "digital work environment", as used in Swedish political debate. These parallels allow CSCW research to inform future design patterns or assist in the development of entirely new tools. CSCW addresses how computer systems can support collaborative activity and coordination. More specifically, the field of CSCW seeks to analyze and draw connections between currently understood human psychological and social behaviors and available collaborative tools, or groupware.
