Sylvester the Cat Pussycat Sr. enraged cats beat up Daffy. He appeared in 103 cartoons in the golden age of American animation, lagging only behind superstars Bugs Bunny, Porky Pig, and Daffy Duck. Most of his appearances have him often chasing Tweety, Speedy Gonzales, or Hippety Hopper. In the television series Tiny Toon Adventures, Sylvester appeared as the mentor of Furrball. Three of his cartoons won Academy Awards, the most for any starring a Looney Tunes character: they are Tweetie Pie, Speedy Gonzales, and Birds Anonymous. is a cartoon character, an anthropomorphic cat in the Looney Tunes and Merrie Melodies series of cartoons.
