== Portfolio == Overview Before the introduction of the Joint University Programmes Admissions System (JUPAS) in 1990, tertiary education institutions in Hong Kong had independent admission processes, and students had to take one of two separate entrance examinations. The Hong Kong Advanced Level Examination (HKALE), designed for a three-year tertiary education curriculum, was primarily used by the University of Hong Kong (HKU). Meanwhile, the Hong Kong Higher Level Examination (HKHLE), designed for a four-year tertiary education curriculum, was mainly used by The Chinese University of Hong Kong (CUHK). EUSPA operates the Galileo and European Geostationary Navigation Overlay Service (EGNOS) programmes with the aim of providing a European GNSS alternative to the American, Russian and Chinese systems (e.g. GPS, Glonass and BeiDou). Unlike these other GNSS programmes, Galileo remains under civil control. Many programs focus on delivering a capability to change and are normally designed to deliver the organization's strategy or business transformation. Program management also emphasizes the coordinating and prioritizing of resources

across projects, managing links between the projects and the overall costs and risks of the program. Even though EEP participation is mainly reserved for EAZA zoos, it is possible for non-EAZA collections to be included in these programmes. Each EEP has a coordinator who is assisted by a species committee. The coordinator collects information on the status of all the animals kept in EAZA zoos and aquariums of the species for which he or she is responsible, produces a studbook, carries out demographic and genetic analyses, produces a plan for the future management of the species and provides recommendations to participating institutions.
