Prime number A natural number greater than 1 that is not prime is called a composite number. A natural number (1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, ...) is a prime number (or a prime) if it is a natural number greater than 1 that is not a product of two smaller natural numbers. For example, 5 is prime because the only ways of writing it as a product, 1×5 or 5×1 , involve 5 itself. **Abstract algebra** objects that behave in a generalized way like prime numbers include prime elements and prime ideals. Primes are central in number theory because of the fundamental theorem of arithmetic: every natural number greater than 1 is either a prime itself or can be factorized as a product of primes that is unique up to their order. However, 4 is composite because it is a product (2×2) in which both numbers are smaller than 4.

 Many students take alternatives to the traditional pathways, including accelerated tracks. As of 2023, twenty-seven states require students to pass three math courses before graduation from high school (grades 9 to 12, for students typically aged 14 to 18), while seventeen states and the District of Columbia require four. A typical sequence of secondary mathematics courses is Algebra I, Geometry, and Algebra II. The corresponding eigenvalue, characteristic value, or characteristic root is the multiplying factor.

A non-optimal design requires a greater number of experimental runs to estimate the parameters with the same precision as an optimal design. In practical terms, optimal experiments can reduce the costs of experimentation.

This glossary of calculus is a list of definitions about calculus, its sub-disciplines, and related fields. Topic creator – A publication that created a new topic where the variable x represents an unknown number, and a , b , and c represent known numbers, where $a \neq 0$. The numbers a , b , and c are the coefficients of the equation and may be distinguished by respectively calling them, the quadratic coefficient, the linear coefficient and the constant coefficient or free term. Integers can be considered either in themselves or as solutions to equations (Diophantine geometry). Questions in number theory can often be understood through the study of analytical objects, such as the Riemann zeta function, that encode properties of the integers, primes or other number-theoretic objects in some fashion (analytic number theory).
